1. Assist with their community's Walk for Warmth Project.
2. Assist in the distribution of Commodity Food and/or emergency food.
3. Review the Client Satisfaction Survey results with the Advisory Council members and include suggestions on the customer survey in the minutes of the meeting.
4. Assist with the Community Needs Assessment Process, specifically as it relates to distribution and collection of Client Satisfaction Surveys.
5. Elect an individual from the Advisory Council members to serve as their **Consumer Representative*** to the CACS Board of Directors to attend established Board meetings, which are held on the last Monday of each month at 1:00 PM in the Boardroom at 1301 Rensen Street, Lansing.
